Bering Yachts in brief

Bering Yachts creates a new caliber of a vessel: recreational steel boat that provides an unequaled level of luxury, capability and safety. Taking design cues from proven oceangoing commercial trawlers, these yachts can cross any ocean comfortably, securely and with a minimal number of stops. We blend comfort and reliability to withstand any forces the nature can bring.

We are special. Being a full production cycle, we develop a concept, manufacture the boat in-house, and then equip it with our own luxury furniture. Bering Yachts satisfy even the most meticulous client, and our customer service truly is second to none.





Exteriors

Bering 80 is not that typical compact explorer. With just above 26.2 meters LOA (waterline length of 24 meters) and 8.17 meters beam, Bering 80 is possibly the widest boat in her class. In reality, that means the owner can enjoy the same comfort and facilities typical for superyachts of 24m+ class without messing with complex regulations.

Bering 80 has a displacement of 220 tons — nearly the maximum possible for her size. As a result, this vessel will be rock-stable in any conditions you may encounter and very smooth underway.

This yacht is by far the most long-range traveler of her class. The fuel tanks bear a tremendous amount: 38.5 tons. Powered by the double 450 HP Cummins QSM-11 set, the vessel can cruise at 8.5 knots for a great 5,000 miles. The maximum speed is almost 11 knots.











Interiors

Another unique feature of Bering 80 is her abundant living space.

The saloon has a formal dining area for all guests and a relaxing zone with multimedia further complemented by the covered cockpit.

Easily customizable for any client needs, Bering 80 can accommodate up to 10 guests, apart from the master stateroom and 4 crew, even on a long-term voyage.

The capacity can be adjusted to accommodate a sauna, additional wardrobe, or storage rooms at the lower deck.

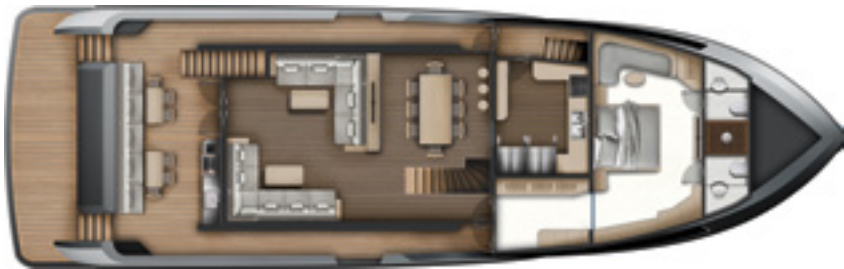




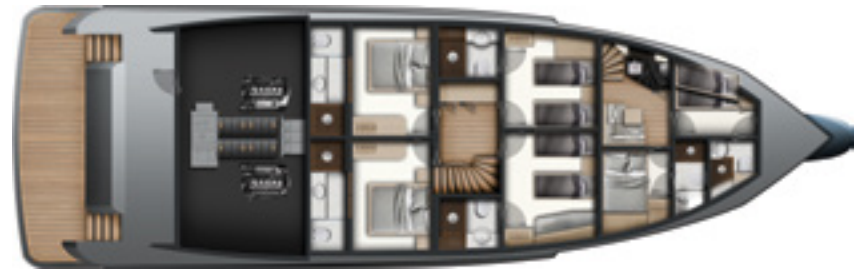
Top View
